Inspection Tips. 1) Window / door frames - cracks and gaps at corners. 2) Driveway cracks 3) Foundation movement and exterior cracking. 4) Increased hillside erosion. 5) Water mains & fire hydrants.

Inspect monthly, photograph and date damages that have occurred at your residence. Also record the date and time of any interior frame noise or creaking.

Cracks and ground movement damage is likely to continue with planned expansion of PXP oil production. CEQA lawsuits have been filed. Property damage lawsuits are likely to follow.
